The Position

Disability Services Workers (DSW), provide individuals with physical, behavioural, emotional and social supports & supervision within the residence and community. Disability Service Workers develop relationships and act as a liaison with family members, guardians, the community, and employers.

In Your Role You Will

- Assist and support individuals with developing and achieving personal goals.
- Ensure individuals basic needs for food, water, clothing and shelter, but also sanitation, education, and healthcare.
- Assist with day to day operation and maintenance of the facility (which may include food preparation, cleaning, and/or assisting the person in service with the completion of these tasks, etc.)
- They also participate, plan & transport the individuals to vocational, recreational, & leisure activities or

events in order to encourage social interaction & community involvement.
